Here black Galloway has been used in nature preservation since 1973. Rita and Jon Buttenschøn will tell us about research in nature preservation with Galloway.

Jan Mouritzen, who takes care of the animals, will show us the Galloway's and talk about the daily routines.

PROGRAM FOR EXCURSIONS

2. September

09:00 Bus to Zealand.

First stop Knud Hansen, Høng, who has a small stock of red Galloway.

Lunch

12:30 Bus leave for Vesterlyng in the bay of Sejerø. Here 65 black Galloway's with calves are grazing the nature area which is around 300 ha.

The animals are a part of Niels Erik Nielsens stock - Skaaninggårdens Galloway.

17:00 Bus leave for Bromølle Inn. This old place has existed as an Inn since 1198.

Dinner at Bromølle Inn

19:30 Bus returns to Hotel Pejsegaarden.

3. September

09:00 Bus leave for Aalestrup Breeding Station, here the national Danish beef cattle consultant Jørgen Skov Nielsen will tell us about individual tests for beef cattle bulls.

11:30 Bus leave for Hjerl Hede open air museum, which is situated in a 1200 ha. Nature area. There are 50 antic farm buildings, restored old buildings – among others farmhouses, blacksmiths and schools.

15:00 Bus leave to Inger Marie and Børge Nielsen, Norsgaard Galloway, Spøttrup. We will meet their Black Belted Galloway.

17:15 Bus returns to Hotel Pejsegaarden.

4. September

Check out Pejsegaarden.

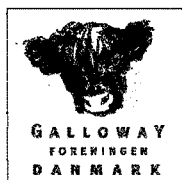
09:30 Bus to Årø Sund. Departure (Sailing) to Årø 11:20.
